



EUROPEAN PRICE REPORT

Latest trends

European seafood traders are getting ready for the holiday season, generally a main consumption period. The signs are positive: with lower inflation in the region, consumers are more willing to travel as well as go to restaurants, which comprise one major outlet for seafood products. In addition, the prices of both farmed and wild-caught seafood are declining, influenced by the stabilization of the cost of fuel.

The euro area annual inflation rate was 2.4 percent in April 2024, which is stable compared to March 2024. Comparatively, a year earlier, the rate was 7.0 percent. In the European Union, the annual inflation was 2.6 percent in April 2024, again stable compared to March 2024. The present price report shows declining prices for 30 percent of the fish recorded, with 21 percent increases for some species and the remaining prices staying stable.

GROUNDFISH

Plant based seafood products are becoming more important in Europe. It is worth noting that the value of plant-based seafood sales in Europe has been growing significantly, with a 326% increase between 2020 and 2022. However, in Spain, plant-based seafood substitutes seem to be the least popular among consumers, regardless of their dietary preferences. Only eight percent of respondents reported consuming seafood alternatives. Spanish consumers expressed a desire for more options like plant-based fish sticks and canned fish (e.g., canned tuna) on supermarket shelves.


GRUNDFISH (cont.)

A group of over 20 Spanish seafood companies and consumer unions has accused plant-based seafood producers of misleading consumers through their product labelling. Announcing their intention to join SAFE Food Advocacy Europe to urge European authorities to place stricter regulations on the description of plant-based products, they assert that such foods should not be able to imitate fish or shellfish.

While they claim that their objections are mostly centred around the “deception” of consumers, there are clearly other factors at play. Rather, it appears to be a clear case of seafood producers feeling threatened by the increasing adoption of seafood alternatives, and attempting to damage their plant-based competitors as a result.

These organizations are objecting not only to the use of words such as “fish” on plant-based product packaging, but also to the use of phrases or images that evoke the ocean, claiming that this is confusing for consumers (despite the fact that some plant-based seafood products do contain ocean-derived ingredients such as algae).



TUNA - BILLFISHES

Fishing in the Western and Central Pacific Ocean is reported to be moderate, with almost no yellowfin in sight. The demand for raw material remains high as canneries in Thailand are filled with finished goods orders. Meanwhile, the skipjack price continues to rise, a trend that will become more noticeable in the Bangkok market following the upcoming FAD closure which will commence on 1 July through 15 August.


Catching in the Indian Ocean is poor. Fishing effort is also reduced as some boats have entered dock for maintenance during this low catching period to save on fuel costs. With the drop in catches, both skipjack and yellowfin prices have risen.

Fishing in the Atlantic Ocean has also fallen to the poor level and local canneries continue to be low on raw material, especially yellowfin. While the price for skipjack is stable, the yellowfin price has sharply increased.


Meanwhile, catches in the Eastern Pacific Ocean remain good; local canneries are still full and only receiving raw materials as necessary. As a result, fishing vessels are having to wait for 2–3 weeks to unload. Accordingly, both skipjack and yellowfin prices have softened.

In the European market, skipjack is down in both demand and price levels, while the yellowfin price has risen sharply due to short supply. The price for cooked, single-cleaned skipjack loins has decreased in line with the raw material trend.


TUNA - Indian/Atlantic Oceans



TUNA - Spanish canneries




TUNA - Loins



CEPHALOPODS

Octopus catching in Indonesia is slowing down with the approach of the low production season, resulting in lower daily volumes in Java than during the peak season. However, in some areas, catches are still ongoing and mostly comprising big sizes.

SQUID - in Italy, origin: South Africa




Squid is in good supply in the European market, with prices starting to go down. Demand is strong at the moment, due to the approaching of the holiday season. Prices are likely to stabilize at the present level.

CRUSTACEANS

Shrimp raw material prices have bottomed out as demand is low. Packers in the United States of America are operating very slowly as the countervailing duty on imported shrimp takes effect. Meanwhile, the sustained weakness of the Japanese currency is impacting upon the domestic market. Demand in Europe is better, taking advantage of ample supply.

ARGENTINA RED SHRIMP - origin: Argentina




Lobster prices are moving down, which is normal for this time of the year when both European and Canadian lobsters reach the market. Lobster prices from Yemen have gone down by USD 0.80 per kg since May.

BIVALVES

At a time when food safety is the focus of public attention, a recent recall notice from an Italian supermarket chain underscores the need for vigilance. The recall concerns some batches of clams from Sardinia, sold in the chain's supermarkets, and which have been deemed unfit for consumption. The specific cause of this measure was not specified, but the stated objective was to prevent any risks to consumers.


MUSSEL BOUCHOT - in France



SMALL PELAGICS

The outlook for Atlanto-Scandian herring is not good over the next decade or so. If overfishing is not stopped immediately, Europe's herring industry is likely to face a collapse by 2026. However, at the same time, brighter news is being reported from other regions. Scotland claims that measures introduced by the country to rebuild the herring stocks in its waters are now beginning to show results. Recently, the Scottish Government announced that the herring stocks in Scottish waters had started to return, and that a vast herring spawning ground had been identified off the coast of Wester Ross in the northwest highlands of Scotland.


Mackerel - in Italy, origin: France



Russian landings of Pacific herring in the Far East showed signs of increasing in January 2024. A total of 83 500 tonnes were landed during that month, 70 percent more than in January 2023. In 2023, Russian landings of herring in the Far East for the whole year amounted to 396 000 tonnes.

FRESHWATER


The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland has become the major importer of pangasius in Europe. During the first four months of the year, imports reached 5 000 tonnes, on par with the corresponding figure of 2023. The main supplier is Viet Nam. Poland is now the main importer of pangasius in the European Union, but its import volume is only half of the UK imports.



SALMON

According to the Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC), Norway exported 82 662 tonnes of salmon worth NOK 10.1 billion in May 2024, which meant an increase of two percent in terms of volume and eight percent in terms of value compared with the same month last year. These figures mean that for Norway, salmon is the largest and most important export species by far.

The NSC noted that May was the first month in 2024 to register a growth for salmon in terms of both volume and value. Exports of fillets have continued to increase compared with last year. The price of fresh salmon fillets is at a record high (NOK 164 per kg), up NOK 5 per kg compared to the previous record month, which was April 2023.



The three most important markets for Norwegian salmon were Poland, Denmark and Spain.

TROUT


The NSC has reported exciting developments for trout, noting that May 2024 was a historic month as the export value of the fish has never been higher in a single month. According to analysts from the institution, although trout accounted for only five percent of the total value of farmed salmonids in May, growth was strong.

In that month, Norway exported 5 561 tonnes of trout worth NOK 587 million, which represented an outstanding 83 percent growth in terms of volume and 65 percent in value compared to May 2023. This represented a record high export value for trout in a single month, up NOK 20 million compared to August 2023, the previous record.

Ukraine, the United States of America and Thailand were the largest markets for trout in May 2024.

SEABREAM/SEABASS

Seabass trade in the first quarter of 2024 increased by 8.3 percent compared to 2023 levels, with the three largest markets of Italy, Spain and the United States of America all exhibiting high growth rates. Spain, which had previously seen a 13 percent decrease in imports between 2022-2023, increased imports by 9 percent to 7 700 tonnes in the first quarter of 2024. This was largely a reflection of weak domestic production last year, which fell by some 4 percent in 2023 compared to 2022. Stocking levels in the country for 2024 harvest have increased notably, with production expected to reach 27 000 tonnes, a 15 percent increase on 2023 output.





SEABREAM/SEABASS (cont.)

The United States of America meanwhile saw imports in the first quarter of the year grow by 6.5 percent between 2022-2023 and by a further 7.6 percent between 2023-2024, solidifying its position as an increasingly important destination for seabass trade. US demand for European seabass, typically sold as a high end fish in Italian style restaurants and marketed under its Italian name 'branzino', is almost entirely supported by imports, with just one known US company supplying a modest 125 tonnes a year from recirculating aquaculture systems.

Prices for both seabass and seabream showed little variation between May and June on the Spanish wholesale market. Seabass prices remain marginally lower than levels at the start of year for small and large gradings, although medium sized fish sold for an average of EUR 6.70 per kg, 18 percent lower than the beginning of the year. Prices for small and medium sized seabream remain significantly higher than early 2024 levels at EUR 6.15 per kg and EUR 6.30 per kg, respectively.
