EUROPEAN PRICE REPORT

Latest trends

Trading is slowing down, as the supply for the holiday season is already secured. Besides, some processing companies in southern Europe close for the summer period. Product prices are rising steadily for some capture fish; for instance, sole prices are about EUR 5.00 per kg ahead of what they were at the same time last year.

In contrast, prices of cultured species such as seabass and seabream are stable, although salmon prices have declined further. Small pelagic catches are good at the moment, practically in all European waters and for all species. As a result, their prices are dropping drastically, sometimes by half compared to just one month earlier.

GROUNDFISH

Prices of cod continue to go up due to low catch quotas at present and in the near future. The Russian-Norwegian research group for the Barents Sea is advising a 31 percent cut in the cod quota for 2025 to just 311 587 tonnes, which is to be shared between Russia and Norway. If approved, this will be the lowest cod quota since 2003. The group also advises that the 2025 haddock quota in the Barents Sea should be cut to 106 912 tonnes, a 16 percent reduction compared to 2024. This follows a 24 percent reduction in 2024 compared to 2023.



GROUNDFISH (cont.)

Normally, quota cuts for cod in the Barents Sea have not exceeded 20 percent, but apparently, a more drastic measure is now called for. According to the researchers, an improved quota can be expected in 2026 if the advice for 2025 is followed by the authorities.


The groundfish processing industry in Europe is entering the holiday season, with some plants reducing production and others put on hold. Groundfish supplies are therefore low, but prices are stable; the exception is cod, for which prices are going up due to lower TACs and the overall difficult resource situation.



TUNA - BILLFISHES

The 1.5-month FAD closure in the Western and Central Pacific commenced on 1 July. Fishing has slowed down to the moderate-to-poor level, with yellowfin catches being minimal. Meanwhile, the raw material demand from Thai canneries remains high. With the reduction in catching, skipjack prices have increased again.

Catching in the Indian Ocean has improved to the moderate level, especially for yellowfin, with some fleets already approaching their 2024 quota limit for the species. Yellowfin prices are down because of the improved catching but skipjack prices have continued to increase due to strong demand from Europe.




TUNA – BILLFISHES (cont.)

Fishing in the Atlantic Ocean remains poor with a high percentage of bycatch, causing canneries to be short of raw material, especially yellowfin. Despite the poor fishing, both skipjack and yellowfin prices have fallen.


No change in the Eastern Pacific Ocean as fishing remains good and the local canneries are still receiving raw materials at production rate only. Fishing vessels are still having to wait for two weeks before unloading at busy ports. The skipjack price remains stable, and is now USD 300 per tonne below the Bangkok level while yellowfin prices are down.

In the European market, demand for skipjack has picked up and prices have gone up, particularly for cooked, single-cleaned skipjack loins. However, yellowfin prices have fallen due to the improvement in Indian Ocean catches.

TUNA - Loins




CEPHALOPODS

Squid is in substantial supply at the moment, as catches by Argentina are reportedly good. Prices have stayed stable though, as demand is strong.

The closed fishing season for squid in South Africa ended on 30 June. While the season started again on 1 July, the bad weather has severely curtailed fishing activities. Traders are holding back from entering the market until they have some idea of how good the catches will be.

SQUID - in Italy, origin: South Africa




In late June, it was announced that Morocco was increasing its octopus quotas by 19 percent to 17 200 tonnes for the season. The frozen-at-sea quota was increased by 20 percent to 9 828 tonnes, while the trawler quota was raised to 1 716 tonnes, and the artisanal quota to 4 056 tonnes.

During the first months of 2024, prices had been well below the levels of both 2023 and 2022. However, with the closure of the Mauritanian octopus season on 20 April and the depleted cold storage holdings in the main markets, Italy and Spain, price levels have since risen. With the higher Moroccan quota, prices are likely to decline in coming months. Demand for octopus is strong due to the holiday season, one of the main consumption periods in Europe.

Octopus is harvested from the waters off the islands of Indonesia, such as Java, Sulawesi, Sumatera and Lombok. The present low catches are keeping prices from rising but from October, the landed volume around Java is estimated to go up.

CRUSTACEANS

At present, the shrimp fisheries in Argentina is reportedly good, with medium-sized shrimp being landed. Prices have stabilized at the EUR 6.50–7.30 per kg level for the 20–30 and 30–40 pieces per kg sizes.



Prices of Indonesian shrimp have risen due to the current low supply and the impact of the US antidumping tax of around six percent on the product. Faced with a situation that does not cover their costs, farmers are refraining from stocking their ponds. At the same time, packers say that the present price of raw material is too high and that they are finding it difficult to get a good selling price. Price levels will adjust eventually in a month or two, and be lower in line with the market demand.

The European market is amply supplied by lobster from North America and northern Europe. Prices are down by EUR 3.00 per kg compared with June 2024 levels. In May, lobster catches in Atlantic Canada were at a record high level; so high, in fact, that it was reportedly difficult to sell it all. Processors were working at full capacity, but the lobsters kept piling up, which some claimed was partly due to a reduced demand for lobsters in China.




BIVALVES

For anyone with questions on the ideal season to eat mussels, the opinion held generally in France is that mussels are best eaten during the months with an "r", that is: January, February, March, April, September, October, November and December. However, other consumers insist that mussels are only eaten during the months with a "ber", i.e.: September, October, November and December. Actually, every month lends itself perfectly to eating mussels, and in France, one can eat mussels all year round, especially with modern refrigeration systems. As a general rule, green mussels are at their best from April to August while the best season for bouchot mussels is from September to April.

Bouchot mussels, named after the special stakes ("bouchots") on which they grow, are a delicacy known for their sweet, succulent flesh and rich seafaring taste. While Normandy is a major culture area, there are also Morisseau bouchot mussels which are grown near the bay of Mont-Saint-Michel, in France. The culture process of these latter mussels is unique: they attach themselves to the Morisseau bouchots of Mont-Saint-Michel which are located in shallow coastal waters, and are maintained by hand for several months. The main difference between the bouchot mussels of Morisseau and those of Normandy lies in the quality of the water, with Morisseau bouchot mussels being softer and sweeter, and having a unique saltiness that reflects the taste of the sea.

Production in France of bouchot mussels has just started. Prices are high at EUR 6.20 per kg, some three percent ahead of last year's level. These mussels reach maturity in October/November and are ideally eaten until the beginning of April, but they are also readily available in supermarkets until July. It is during this period that the meatiest bouchot mussels are available.




SMALL PELAGICS

Small pelagics are generally in good supply, especially from the Mediterranean Sea. Summer is usually not a very good consumption period for this type of fish due to high temperature, but overall, demand is stable and prices are coming down significantly. The Spanish wholesale price for fresh sardine was EUR 2.00 per kg in July, EUR 1.00 per kg less than last month. Anchovy prices went down even more drastically, from EUR 4.50 per kg in June to EUR 2.50 per kg in July in the Barcelona wholesale market. Similarly, prices of mackerel and horse mackerel have declined.

FRESHWATER


Tilapia is not really a favourite item in the European market. Total imports into the European Union are around 40 000 tonnes per year, a small amount when compared with 84 000 tonnes of pangasius and 45 000 tonnes of Nile perch. The main European importing countries for tilapia are the Kingdom of the Netherlands and France, while the leading supplier is China, which accounts for 90 percent of the tilapia supply shipped to the European Union.

SALMON

The Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC) reported a demanding situation in the first half of the year with biological challenges that resulted in lower harvesting volumes and a change in product composition towards more fillets.

Norway exported 500 660 tonnes of salmon worth NOK 56.3 billion in the first half of the year, which represented declines of four percent and three percent, respectively, compared with the same period of last year. Poland, Denmark and the United States of America were the largest markets for the species in the reviewed period.

According to NSC data, the price of fresh whole salmon reached a record high of NOK 107 per kg, up NOK 1 from the previous record in the first half of 2023. In May, the export price for fresh salmon was NOK 116.66 per kg, falling to NOK 85.85 per kg in June, a record decline of NOK 30.81 per kg. In that month (June 2024), Norway exported 93 400 tonnes worth NOK 8.9 billion, down four percent and 15 percent, respectively, compared with June last year.



Of particular note is the fact that the fall in seafood export value in June was the second largest ever, measured against June 2023. Salmon comprises 70 percent of the total value of Norwegian seafood exports and thus, the significant decline in June was caused by a drastic fall in the price of fresh whole salmon. The fall in value in June 2024 was only beaten by March this year, but that change must be seen in the context of Easter.

Analysts of the institution pointed out that global competition is increasing and this has particularly affected prices to markets that have traditionally paid the most for salmon. In June, there was a big drop in prices to markets such as Italy, Republic of Korea, China and the United States.



TROUT


Contrary to salmon, Norwegian trout figures were more positive. A total of 29 839 tonnes worth NOK 2.9 billion were exported in the first half of 2024, representing growths of 44 percent in terms of volume and 27 percent in value, as compared to the same period in 2023. In June alone, Norway exported 6 300 tonnes of trout worth NOK 502 million, up 27 percent in volume but down three percent in value. Ukraine, the United States and Thailand were the most important markets in the period under review.

The NSC noted that in Ukraine, which is a market for both salmon and trout, the export volume of salmonids increased by 11 percent, despite a 30 percent decline in salmon. This shift towards trout in Ukraine must be seen in the context of price comparison. So far this year, the average price of salmon to Ukraine is NOK 111.29 per kg, while the average price of fresh trout is NOK 88.69 per kg.

SEABREAM/SEABASS

Consumption levels remain notably lower compared to the previous year, with the approach of high summer generating little change in demand. Producers are navigating a highly challenging market, where inflation and rising production costs significantly constrain profitability.

Exports from Turkey, bolstered by a weakened exchange rate, increased to 51 500 tonnes in the first five months of the year (+16.5 percent) as compared to the same period in 2023. However, other producers such as Greece and Spain saw drops to 35 000 tonnes (-23.7 percent) and 7 600 tonnes (-23.3 percent), respectively. Seabass harvests from Greece are expected to increase towards the end of the summer, which is likely to stabilize prices.





SEABREAM/SEABASS (cont.)

Despite slow demand, seabream prices have shown a strong recovery since the start of the year, reversing the trend in the past couple of years when seabass had exceeded seabream in price. For instance, while seabass on the Italian market had enjoyed a margin of between EUR 0.20–0.50 per kg over seabream throughout 2022 and 2023, since January 2024, seabream has been the more expensive of the two. Nevertheless, prices for both species have remained remarkably stable since March of this year, with the level for small and medium-sized fish on the Spanish wholesale market fluctuating by less than five percent over the last five months. In general, these prices are approximately 30 percent below their peak in July 2023 for that market.

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
