Latest trends

The last 12 issues of the European Price Report showed an overall declining trend for fish prices in Europe, influenced by the ample supply of some important items such as shrimp and squid. In addition, inflation in the European Union is under control now, close to the two percent mark. The main exception to this trend was groundfish species, prices of which increased by 10 percent during the period under review (September 2023 to August 2024).

Sales during the tourist season in the summer of 2024 were very good, as European citizens took advantage of the increase in their disposable incomes. As a result, the restaurant sector saw a spike in consumption of fishery products, always considered a luxury item on their menus as compared to red meat. Shrimp and cephalopods were in good demand, mainly in the Mediterranean countries, but high production of these species, especially in South America, led to lower prices. The species that increased its presence in the market the most due to high restaurant demand was shrimp, for which turnover increased by about 10 percent in the course of the summer of 2024. The cumulative imports of shrimp into the European Union during the first half of the year increased by five percent in quantity terms. Similar to the shrimp trade, lobster and crab were also in excellent demand, and prices were good. In contrast, tuna experienced a downward price trend in the world market due to lower demand for canned products.

LATEST TRENDS (cont.)

The 40th Anniversary of the FAO GLOBEFISH project, held on 18 and 19 September 2024 at FAO headquarters in Rome, Italy, was a significant milestone in the history of GLOBEFISH. This hybrid event brought together a wide range of stakeholders from across the fisheries and aquaculture sectors, marking four decades of invaluable contributions made by GLOBEFISH to global markets, trade, and fisheries management. The event welcomed 78 in-person attendees, alongside more than 50 online participants, who actively contributed to the discussions on the future of fisheries and aquaculture. The programme featured a series of keynotes, panel discussions, and dialogues on pressing topics.

The two-day event aligned closely with the Blue Transformation agenda, advocating for sustainable trade in fisheries and aquaculture products; improving food access; and promoting the fair and inclusive development of aquatic food value chains. Discussions were framed by the four pillars of FAO's strategy: better production, better nutrition, a better environment, and a better life.


GROUNDFISH

Norway is one of the main cod exporters in the world. During September 2024, export prices for fresh cod declined by EUR 0.10 per kg and for frozen cod by EUR 0.15 per kg. It is likely that this is only a seasonal trend, and that as winter approaches, cod prices will increase again due to limited supply and low catch quotas.


In the Italian market, the limited supply of cod led to a substantial price increase between August and September 2024. Fresh cod fillets were selling at some EUR 0.40 per kg more than usual.

TUNA - BILLFISHES


Fishing in the Western and Central Pacific Ocean has slowed down further to the moderate-to-poor level, mainly due to bad weather and strong currents. Thai canneries are reportedly well-stocked from the carrier landings in the previous months, while the skipjack price has fallen sharply again. Numerous carriers have been diverted away from the Thailand market due to better pricing elsewhere, especially Manta, Ecuador, where the price is now USD 150 per tonne higher than in Bangkok.



Catching in the Indian Ocean is reported to be very poor, especially for skipjack. Local canneries are now short of raw materials. As a result, the skipjack price is increasing while the yellowfin price remains stable.



Fishing in the Atlantic Ocean has slowed down and is back to the poor level again. Local canneries remain short of raw material. The skipjack price is up slightly while the price for yellowfin, which is in short supply, remains high.



The first 72-day IATTC 'veda' in the Eastern Pacific Ocean will remain in force until 8 October 2024. Vessels that choose to continue operating during this period report that fishing has fallen to the moderate level. With the drop in catches and fishing efforts, both skipjack and yellowfin prices have increased.



TUNA – BILLFISHES (cont.)

In the European market, the price of skipjack is down while the yellowfin price is stable. Meanwhile, the price for cooked, single-cleaned skipjack loins has dropped further.

CEPHALOPODS

A number of containers confirmed at the close of the squid season in South Africa were delayed in getting shipped and were delivered to European customers after prices had started to fall. This meant that buyers renegotiated lower prices, with large squid prices decreasing by as much as EUR 3.00 per kg. These prices are presently in flux, and while there have been shipments at lower costs, many exporters are reluctant to accept a sharp decrease. The supply/demand equation is also volatile as catching has slowed down after a good start to the reopening of the season, due partially to winter weather.

The sharp reduction in prices in the European market was prompted by record catches of squid in Argentina, with indications that the catch for the total squid season will be approximately 180 000 tonnes, the highest in recent history. Most of these squid ends up in the European market, having a depressing effect on the price

levels, which had been very high last year. Catches around the Falkland Islands (Malvinas) have been good too. Meanwhile, Spain imported some 46 000 tonnes from the SW Atlantic in the first half of 2024, which compares to 35 500 tonnes in the same period of 2023. The impact on prices in the European market was significant.


CEPHALOPODS (cont.)

Yet another important aspect for seafood trade is the emergence of seafood alternatives, one of the latest trial products being 3D-printed plant-based calamari rings that aim to replicate the taste, texture, and protein content of real calamari. Researchers combined microalgae and mung beans, two protein-rich plant sources, to create a vegan paste. They integrated omega-3 fatty acids into the paste, enhancing its nutritional composition to match that of genuine calamari. Using a 3D printer, the paste was transformed into intricately-layered rings, closely mimicking the texture and structure of calamari. The 3D-printed food then underwent cooking tests, including air-frying, which garnered positive results. The researchers are now actively refining the composition to attain optimal elasticity and sensory qualities, particularly ensuring that it is allergen-free.

CRUSTACEANS

Shrimp are in good demand at the moment in the European market. Despite the strong demand, prices of Argentine shrimp have dropped by up to EUR 0.60 per kg in the last few months due to the exceptionally good catches.

ARGENTINA RED SHRIMP - origin: Argentina




Lobster and crab are also well demanded at the moment, but catches are high leading to generally lower prices in the main European markets, such as Spain and France.

BIVALVES

The regional fisheries office in Veneto, Italy, recently delivered over 14 million specimens of clam seed to some 1 500 fishermen from the Portotollose Consortium of Scardovari. This move is aimed at revitalizing the local clam industry in the wake of the devastating impact of the invasive blue crab in the region. Paradoxically, the crab, after having proliferated because of the warm waters in the area, now seems to be a victim of a mucilage event. Unconfirmed reports say that only last week in Porto Tolle, about 100 kilograms of dead blue crabs were found on the beach.

Trade associations have called for ongoing scientific monitoring and data collection in order to understand the impact of this alien species on the ecosystem, and therefore develop effective strategies. In 2023, from July to November, almost 427 thousand kgs of blue crab were disposed of, while from March to the end of July 2024, the figure was slightly over 403 thousand. Although about 44 thousand kgs of blue crab were sold from January–June 2024 (510 thousand kgs in 2023, from July to December), the demand for the product in commercial channels is low.


MUSSEL BOUCHOT - in France



SMALL PELAGICS

Mackerel export prices have declined slightly, as reported by sources in Norway. The supply seems sufficient, while the demand for fresh mackerel in Europe is good. Norwegian herring export prices are generally stable, with a tiny upward trend.


Mackerel - in Italy, origin: France



FRESHWATER

In the first half of 2024, the European Union imported 35 000 tonnes of pangasius (mainly from Viet Nam), down by 2 000 tonnes from the same period of 2023. The leading EU importer was the Kingdom of the Netherlands with 7 400 tonnes; second was Germany with 5 800 tonnes, on par with the first half of 2023. Spain, which in the past had been the main EU importing country for pangasius, reported an increase of 1 000 tonnes to reach 3 800 tonnes in the first half of 2024.

Pangasius - in Italy, origin: Viet Nam




SALMON

August 2024 was a record export month for Norwegian salmon in terms of price and volume, with 125 521 tonnes of salmon worth NOK 10.8 billion (EUR 916 million). This represents a three percent growth in volume and four percent in value compared with the same month of last year. The largest markets for salmon in August 2024 were Poland, the United States and Denmark.

Nevertheless, the Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC) says that market trends are uncertain. According to their analysis of the global market, the import value in local currency is weakening in several countries and the price of salmon measured in foreign currency has fallen. A lower import price in 2024 has not been compensated by corresponding growth in volume. This applies, for example, to the United States of America, China and Thailand.

SALMON (cont.)

NSC data disseminated by Undercurrent News Price Portal recorded that fresh Atlantic salmon FOB prices regarding sales to export markets at the Norwegian border reached NOK 76.85 (EUR 6.56) at week 34, down 5.2 percent compared to the previous week. Salmon prices continue the downward trend reported in the previous European Price Report, starting from week 19 at NOK 122.10 (EUR 10.43).



TROUT

August 2024 was a very positive month for Norwegian trout exports, which contributed to the best August ever for Norwegian seafood exports in general. Further, according to the Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC), trout accounted for 5.3 percent of the export value, making it Norway's second most important export species.

In that month, Norway exported 9 673 tonnes of trout worth NOK 771 million (EUR 65.3 million), which represented a sharp increase of 44 percent in terms of volume and 36 percent in value compared with August 2023. This was a record high export value in a single month, up NOK 145 million (EUR 12.3 million) from the previous record month, which was in July 2024.

The three largest markets for the species in August 2024 were Ukraine, Lithuania and the United States, with Ukraine registering the greatest growth in value for that month (+ 324 percent).

According to NSC data disseminated by Undercurrent News Price Portal, weekly volumes and FOB prices regarding sales to export markets at the Norwegian border showed that HOG fresh Norwegian trout reached NOK 72.30 (EUR 6.17) at week 34 of 2024. This meant a decline of 1.9 percent compared to the price registered in the previous week, continuing a downward trend decline that started in week 31 at NOK 74.80 (EUR 6.28).


SEABREAM/SEABASS

Türkiye is by far the main seabass exporter worldwide. Its exports are about double the ones of Greece. In the first half of 2024, some 53 000 tonnes of seabass were exported from Türkiye, more than double the Greek figure. Italy is the main importing country, followed by Spain and the United States of America.

Greece continues to be the second major seabass exporter in the world. In the first half of 2024, the country exported some 25 500 tonnes of fresh seabass, some 20 percent more than in the same period of 2023. Main importing country of Greek seabass continues to be Italy, with about 35 percent of Greek seabass exports. Italy increased these imports by some 10 percent to 9 100 tonnes. Spain is second, increasing its imports of seabass from Greece by about the same amount.

In the case of seabream, Greece and Türkiye export about the same quantity, some 30 000 tonnes each in the first half of the year. This meant a 16 percent of the Greek seabream exports, while Türkiye reported a small increase during the period under review over the corresponding 2023 figure.

In September, seabass and seabream prices were about stable on August 2024 figures, with the exception of large seabass which reported a 10 percent price increase.

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
