## Latest trends

The prices of seafood in the European market are moving up for many species due to a combination of factors. On the one hand, importers are buying in view of the Christmas and year-end holidays; on the other hand, species such as groundfish and cephalopods are in limited supply at the moment, with little prospect for improvement in the next six months or so. Among the key points to note in this issue of the European Price Report is that while prices rose for 22 percent of the products and declined for 19 percent, they were stable for other products, especially cultured fish such as seabass and seabream.

### GROUNDFISH

The fish processing and trading industry in the European Union is faced with several challenges, such as increasing competitive pressures in international markets; growing difficulty in securing suitable labour; standards and regulations that vary widely among third countries; and new trade and cooperation agreements that present additional complexities.

In addition, the market supply of groundfish, especially cod, is declining due to quota restrictions, making it more difficult for the fish processing industry in Europe to access stocks. The bans in Europe and the United States of America on imports of fishery products from the Russian Federation have also created a vacuum, particularly as new legal constraints aim to prevent Russian groundfish channelled through China from entering these developed markets. However, one positive sign has been the increase in the cod quota in Canada, after years of closure.

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The European Fish Price Report, based on information supplied by industry correspondents, aims to provide guidance on broad price trends. Price information is indicative and should be used only for forecasting medium- and long-term trends. FAO is not responsible for any errors or omissions.




## GROUNDFISH (cont.)

The Pacific hake autumn season in the United States ended one month earlier than expected due to bad catches. A shortfall in fillets/mince and surimi blocks in the market is expected, leading to higher prices for the species.

Consumption of wet-salted cod fillets from frozen raw material (*Gadus macrocephalus*) and wet-salted cod fillets (*Gadus morhua*) from fresh raw material of Faroese and Icelandic origin is lacklustre because of the persistence of high temperatures in southern Europe. Their consumption is very much linked to ancient cultural traditions, including the fact that, being hot dishes, they are eaten when the weather is cold. As southern Europe is expected to experience lower temperatures in the next few days, the whole sector is hoping for a boost in demand, as in previous years.

### Sole - origin: Netherlands




## TUNA - BILLFISHES

Fishing in the Western and Central Pacific continues to be at the moderate-to-poor level. This, together with the diversion of several carriers to other markets, has resulted in a reduction in carrier activities in Thailand. As such, the skipjack price has rebounded sharply.

Catching in the Indian Ocean remains poor, especially for skipjack. Some vessels have moved further away from their traditional fishing area to look for better catches. Local canneries remain short of raw materials. However, both skipjack and yellowfin prices have decreased.

### TUNA - Pacific Ocean




## TUNA – BILLFISHES (cont.)

Fishing in the Atlantic Ocean has improved to the moderate level, especially for yellowfin. The skipjack price remains stable while the yellowfin price has fallen sharply due to the improved catches.


The first 72-day Inter-American Tropical Tuna Commission (IATTC) 'veda' (ban) in the Eastern Pacific Ocean ended on 8 October. Vessels are reporting good fishing, mainly for skipjack. However, with the reduced landings last month, demand for raw material remains high. The skipjack price continues to increase while yellowfin price is stable.

In the European market, both skipjack and yellowfin prices have fallen due to slower demand. The price for cooked, single-cleaned skipjack loins has also decreased, reflecting the lower cost of the raw material.

## CEPHALOPODS

In 2024, the global squid supply saw a slight increase; production is forecasted to rise to 3.2 million tonnes, representing a three percent increase compared to previous years. This growth can be attributed to the rising demand for squid as a versatile and popular seafood choice.


## CEPHALOPODS (cont.)

The South African squid fishery closes for five weeks from 19 October and catches have been very disappointing. However, these poor catches have not resulted in a firmer market. When the season re-opens there is little time (if any) to get product to Europe for the usual Christmas/New Year market and one would have expected better prices now. The market is asking for small squid (cheap); clearly, the demand for the larger sizes has fallen. The gaps between the grades and the fact that the closed season has not positively affected prices, are concerning. The local currency has also firmed up over the past two months, resulting in lower local currency receipts.

## CRUSTACEANS


Shrimp is the main exception to the general upward trend in crustacean prices. Supply of shrimp in the market is very strong, while demand is rather limited and unlikely to improve even during the upcoming holiday season. Meanwhile, strong arrivals from Ecuador are impacting on wild shrimp. As a result, prices of Argentinean shrimp are declining, even though catches are very limited at the moment.

In Indonesia, shrimp raw material supply is down as compared to the same time last year. The decreasing volume is likely to push prices up until the end of November, although US demand has softened.

## BIVALVES

In 2024, French mussel production has seen some positive trends. The market has been growing steadily, driven by increasing consumer demand for sustainable seafood options. Mussels are popular due to their high protein and omega-3 content, and they are used in a variety of ways, from direct consumption to processed foods and even animal feed. The French mussel market has also benefited from a shift towards healthier eating habits and a greater awareness of the nutritional benefits of mussels. Overall, the outlook for the French mussel industry is optimistic, with expectations of continued growth in the coming years.


### MUSSEL BOUCHOT - in France



In contrast, the Italian clam market in 2024 has faced some challenges. The Scardovari Fishermen's Consortium reported a significant impact due to the presence of blue crabs, which have been devouring juvenile clams and mussels. This has led to a drastic reduction in production, with estimates indicating that they will not be able to reach the usual output levels of 5 000 to 5 500 tonnes. Despite these difficulties, the clam market remains vibrant, driven by consumer demand for sustainable seafood options. The industry is working on strategies to mitigate the impact of these challenges and ensure the continued supply of clams.

## SMALL PELAGICS


The Portuguese sardine market in 2024 has faced some significant challenges. The industry has been under pressure from climate change, which has warmed the waters and affected sardine populations. Additionally, overfishing has contributed to the decline in sardine stocks. To address these issues, the Directorate-General for Natural Resources, Security and Maritime Services (DGRM) has implemented new regulations, including a reduction in the sardine quota. These measures aim to help rebuild the sardine population and ensure sustainable fishing practices. Despite these challenges, the sardine industry remains an important part of Portugal's economy, providing jobs in fishing, processing, and canning. The industry continues to adapt to these changes and work towards a more sustainable future.



## FRESHWATER

The carp market in Germany in 2024 has shown some interesting trends; for example, the retail price for live carp has ranged between EUR 5.99 and EUR 7.92 per kilogram. This price fluctuation is influenced by various factors, including supply and demand dynamics, production costs, and consumer preferences. Overall, the carp market in Germany remains stable, with consistent demand for this popular fish species. Carp is widely consumed during festive seasons, especially around Christmas, which helps sustain the market throughout the year.

The pangasius market in the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland in 2024 has seen significant growth. Despite global inflation, exports of pangasius to the United Kingdom increased by 33 percent in the first half of 2024, compared to the previous year.



## FRESHWATER (cont.)

The growing demand for pangasius can be attributed to the high demand for affordable and versatile white fish in the UK market.

Viet Nam remains a key supplier, with exports reaching USD 64 million in 2022 and continuing to rise in 2024. The attractive prices of pangasius, ranging between USD 2.98 and USD 3.98 per kilogram, have also contributed to this increase.


## SALMON

2024 has been a challenging year so far for the Norwegian salmon industry due to strong market competition and greater production costs. In addition, higher sea temperatures have led to increased salmon lice populations.

Despite this scenario, the third quarter of the year was a strong period for salmon trade, as the country exported 372 442 tonnes worth NOK 31.8 billion (EUR 2 715 million), which meant a volume growth of eight percent and a value increase of three percent compared to the third quarter last year, according to the Norwegian Seafood Council

(NSC) figures. Atlantic salmon contributed 70 percent of the total export value in that period, with Poland, Denmark and the United States as the top three largest markets.

In September alone, Norway exported 141 600 tonnes of salmon worth NOK 11 6 billion (EUR 990 million), up nine percent and six percent, respectively, compared to the same month of 2023.

Nevertheless, the NSC says that market trends are uncertain. According to their analysis of the global market, the import value in local currency is weakening in several countries and the price of salmon measured in foreign currency has fallen. A lower import price in 2024 has not been compensated by corresponding growth in volume. This applies, for example, to the United States of America, China and Thailand.

## TROUT

According to the NSC figures, a historic high record was reached by the end of September 2024 as trout exports exceeded NOK 2 billion in a single quarter. During the July–September 2024 period, Norway exported 25 033 tonnes worth NOK 2 billion (EUR 170 million), meaning an increase of 34 percent in volume and 24 percent in value compared with the third quarter of 2023.

Ukraine, Lithuania and the US market were the largest buyers for Norwegian trout in the period under review.


The species was a key driver in boosting the overall Norwegian seafood exported value. It ranked fourth among the top species exported during that period in terms of value, behind salmon, mackerel and cod. The NSC reported that September 2024 was the first month with a higher average price for fresh whole trout than for fresh whole salmon since May 2023. The average price for fresh whole trout was NOK 75.11 per kg (EUR 6.41), while for salmon, it was NOK 74.04 per kg (EUR 6.32).

Specifically, in September 2024, Norway exported 7 600 tonnes of trout worth NOK 625 million (EUR 53 million), up 22 percent in volume and 15 percent in terms of value.

## SEABREAM/SEABASS

Turkish seabass exports reached 31 900 tonnes in the first eight month of 2024, which was 1 900 tonnes more than in the same period of 2023. The unit value declined during the same periods from USD 6.17 per kg to USD 6.06 per kg. Italy was the main importing country with 4 500 tonnes in the first eight months of the year, up by 1 000 tonnes from the same period of 2023, showing that Italy is directing its imports of seabass from Greece to Türkiye in recent months. However, Greece is still the main supplier of seabass to the Italian market with 12 500 tonnes, which is 1 000 tonnes less than the quantity imported in previous Jan-Aug period. The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland is a close second major importer of seabass from Türkiye with 4 100 tonnes in the first eight months of 2024.

In October 2024, price of seabass from Greece practically stayed the same, with the exception of the 450-600 g category, which increased from September 2024 by EUR 0.20 per kg. Seabream prices stayed stable for all sizes.
