Latest trends

January is normally a relatively quiet month for seafood demand and consumption in Europe. One of the major consumption periods (the year-end festivities) is over while the next peak consumption period (Holy Week just before Easter) is still three months away.

However, this January, prices of seafood in general went up, due to speculation on fuel prices and lower quotas for many capture seafood products. In this issue of the European Fish Price Report, increases were reported for 23 percent of the prices, while 20 percent reported downward prices. The remainder stayed stable at the November 2024 price level.

The annual inflation rate in the Euro Area accelerated for a third straight month to 2.4 percent in December 2024. This was the highest rate since July 2024 compared to 2.2 percent in November 2024, aligned with both market expectations and the preliminary estimate. The increase was largely due to base effects, as last year's sharp declines in energy prices are no longer factored into annual rates.

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

GROUNDFISH

Groundfish is in very short supply at the moment, while demand is strong. Prices are going up for capture groundfish products, in some cases by EUR 3–4 per kg, especially for the larger sizes. A good example is wild turbot from the Kingdom of the Netherlands which is selling at EUR 5.10 per kg more than last month.


Cod supply is low at the moment, and is likely to stay at this level for the remainder of the year. Export prices of fresh cod fillets from Norway averaged NOK 151 per kg (USD 13.40) which is NOK 20 per kg higher than last year. Frozen cod fillet prices increased during the same period from NOK 103 per kg to NOK 136 per kg.

Sole is in good demand in the European market, and prices reached record levels. The No 2 size is selling at EUR 26.60 per kg which compares to EUR 27.40 one year ago. The No 4 size reported slight declines in price levels.




TUNA - BILLFISHES

Fishing in the Western and Central Pacific is reported to be poor for most vessels. Thai canneries remain well-stocked for the time being but will start to face shortage if the situation persists. Despite low supplies, the skipjack price remains stable; however, it is widely expected to increase in the coming weeks.




TUNA – BILLFISHES (cont.)


Most vessels in the Indian Ocean have resumed fishing and catching is reported to be at the moderate level. The demand for raw material is down as local canneries are just starting up after the New Year holiday. The skipjack price continues to fall due to the low demand but remains steady for yellowfin.



Fishing in the Atlantic Ocean has improved to the moderate level but there is a high percentage of small-sized fish and non-tuna species. As such, local canneries are short of raw material, especially for skipjack. Both skipjack and yellowfin prices show increases due to the shortage.



The second 72-day IATTC 'veda' (ban) in the Eastern Pacific Ocean was in force until 19 January. Only 23 percent of the fleet is operating due to a combination of this veda and the year-end holidays. For the vessels that are out fishing, moderate catches are being reported. Carriers from the Western and Central Pacific are continuing to deliver cargo to supplement local landings. There are no changes in the skipjack and yellowfin prices.



There is very little movement in the European market due to the year-end holidays. Skipjack and yellowfin prices remain stable. The price for cooked, single-cleaned skipjack loins also remains unchanged. Meanwhile, the duty-free quota for imports of tuna loins from third countries was exhausted in the first few days of 2025.


CEPHALOPODS

Squid catches were poor in South Africa during the month of December 2024. At the same time, no major sales to Europe were reported. Prices stayed stable, despite low catches.

In 2024, Argentina's squid fishing industry experienced significant growth. The total catch of Illex squid reached approximately 119 000 tonnes, compared to 67 000 tonnes in 2023. This remarkable increase was attributed to the abundant resources off South Patagonia and the efforts of the Argentine jigger fleet.

On 27 December 2024, Morocco announced its octopus' quota for the 2025 winter fishing season. This new quota of 25 500 tonnes represents an increase of 23.6 percent compared to the previous year, reflecting successful efforts to manage and sustain the octopus stocks while meeting market demand. The impact of the quota on octopus' prices still needs to be seen, but it is likely that there will be a declining trend, especially in the Spanish market.


SQUID - in Italy, origin: South Africa



CRUSTACEANS

Current catches of shrimp in Argentina are low while processing activities on land are limited, due to the holiday season. In addition, demand for Argentine shrimp during the Christmas season was very strong, with little holdings in Europe consequently being available. The combination of all these factors has led to an increase in prices, particularly for medium-sized shrimp which went up by EUR 0.20–0.30 per kg, although both big and small sizes stayed stable.


ARGENTINA RED SHRIMP - origin: Argentina



CRUSTACEANS (cont.)


The lobster trade in Europe during the Christmas 2024 period saw strong demand, as lobsters are often considered a festive delicacy. Additionally, many seafood restaurants and markets had featured lobster dishes prominently on their menus. The demand for premium seafood, including lobsters, has remained high due to the increasing appreciation by consumers for fine dining and gourmet experiences.

Crab was also in excellent demand and prices went up strongly during December, however, prices did not come down much during January, due to good demand from the catering sector.



BIVALVES

Italian clams, the key ingredient for one of the nation's favourite pasta dishes, have practically disappeared from fish counters. Cultured Manila clams (*Ruditapes philippinarum*) have been virtually exterminated by an invasion of blue crabs. Furthermore, the native population of wild venus clams (*Venus verrucosa*) that had survived until recently, has been decimated by the wave of mucilage that hit the entire Adriatic coastal strip this summer. In addition, the large gelatinous masses in the summer months had caused considerable damage to fishing gear.



BIVALVES (cont.)

The business, before the arrival of the blue crab and the mucilage, was worth EUR 300 million, but currently, hardly any supply is left. Furthermore, now that the algae have settled on the seabed, they pose an ongoing threat to clams, mussels and cockles, species that are generally sessile and which are dying due to anoxia and rising water temperatures.

For these reasons, fishers have ceased operations and are asking for financial support to carry them through the stoppage period. Meanwhile, in order to maintain supply, Portuguese clams are being imported into the Italian market, where they reign supreme.


A solution to the repopulation of farms in Veneto and Emilia Romagna could come from Portugal, but it is not easy to restart this economy, where Italy was once a leader in Europe. Any effort would require reclaiming the waters from the crab, fencing off the production areas and putting the product back into the water to be farmed. The quantity of seed that is needed is estimated to be billions of specimens of true clams, which would be impossible to find and manage with the 'hatcheries' that exist in Italy at the moment.

SMALL PELAGICS

In 2024, Morocco experienced a decline in sardine production due to several factors, including rising sea temperatures and increased foreign fishing. According to the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries, Rural Development and Forests, the significant drop in sardine stocks led to a surge in prices. Despite these challenges, Morocco remains a major player in the global sardine market, producing around 850 000 tonnes of sardines annually which account for about 62 percent of the country's overall fish harvest. Most of the catches go to fishmeal production.


Industry sources say that although 2024 was a tough year for Moroccan sardine fisheries, there is hope for recovery in the coming season.

FRESHWATER

Pangasius has become a well-liked product on the German market. In fact, this market has become the main outlet in the European Union, while elsewhere in Europe, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland is the major market for pangasius. Imports of frozen pangasius fillets during 2024 were generally stable in these two countries, but saw an increase in Spain, where the species is recovering some lost market presence.



Tilapia is not as popular as pangasius in the European market, with imports remaining at about 40 000 tonnes over past years. The main importing countries are the United Kingdom, Spain and the Kingdom of the Netherlands.


SALMON

2024 was marked by significant production challenges for salmon, including higher sea temperatures and the resulting biological issues, increased costs, and lower average fish weights. Price declines were also recorded.

According to the Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC), Norway exported 1.255 million tonnes of salmon valued at NOK 122.9 billion (EUR 10.3 billion) in 2024. This represented a two percent increase in volume; but more importantly, the one percent rise in value compared to the previous year represented a record high, surpassing the previous record set in 2023 by NOK 617 million (EUR 52 million). In December 2024 alone, Norway exported 112 000 tonnes of salmon worth NOK 11.5 billion (EUR 979 million), reflecting a seven percent rise in volume and a 13 percent increase in value compared to December of the previous year.

SALMON (cont.)

In terms of export markets, Poland, the United States and France were the largest buyers of Norwegian salmon in 2024. The NSC also highlighted the increasingly strong performance in Asia, where salmon is considered an everyday luxury by consumers in countries like Thailand, China, Viet Nam, and the Republic of Korea. Additionally, the incorporation of salmon within fast-food trends such as sushi, sashimi, and poke worldwide, as well as in the popular food segment in Europe, was noted.



NSC data disseminated by Undercurrent News Price Portal recorded that fresh Atlantic salmon FOB prices regarding sales to export markets at the Norwegian border reached NOK 111.89 (EUR 9.44) at week 52, up 20 percent compared to the previous week. Salmon prices had continued an upward trend since week 40 at NOK 69.69 (EUR 5.98) with some slight declines in weeks 47 and 49.

TROUT

According to the Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC), 2024 saw record-high exports of trout, with Norway shipping 75 135 tonnes valued at NOK 6.8 billion (EUR 580 million). This represents a 32 percent increase in volume and a 23 percent rise in value compared to the previous year. Furthermore, the export value for trout throughout 2024 reached a historic high, surpassing the previous record set in 2023 by NOK 1.3 billion (EUR 110 million). In December 2024 alone, Norway exported 7 100 tonnes of trout valued at NOK 641 million (EUR 54 million), reflecting a 41 percent increase in volume and a 38 percent increase in value compared to December of the previous year. In terms of value, trout ranked as the fourth most important export species from Norway.

The NSC attributes the surge in production to a shift in focus by many fish farmers, who have increasingly concentrated on trout farming rather than salmon over the past three years. The previous record volume for trout, 73 727 tonnes, was set in 2008.


TROUT (cont.)

In terms of export markets, Ukraine, the United States and Thailand were the largest destinations for Norwegian trout in 2024.

According to NSC data disseminated by Undercurrent News Price Portal, weekly volumes and FOB prices regarding sales to export markets at the Norwegian border showed that fresh Norwegian trout reached NOK 80.91 (EUR 6.83) at week 52 of 2024. This represented a growth of 11 percent compared to the price registered in the previous week. The price grew again after four consecutive weeks of declines starting in week 47 at NOK 83.90 (EUR 7.22), down to NOK 72.73 (EUR 6.16) at week 51.

SEABREAM/SEABASS

Seabass and seabream are widely available in the market at discounted prices, with Italy continuing to be the main market for seabass and seabream from Greece and Türkiye. In fact, in Italian supermarkets, consumers can always find some seabass or seabream on sale at prices that can be as low as EUR 6.99 per kg. Generally, these specimens come from Türkiye, whereas seabass and seabream from Greece command slightly higher prices. Products from Croatia are priced even higher while species of Italian origin generally sell at double the price of imported products.
