Latest trends

The European Union economy in 2026 is weak, characterized by slow growth, persistent inflationary pressure, and high input costs. These factors combined have translated into higher fish prices and lower per capita consumption, a trend which is expected to continue through the year. In view of the overall bleak economic situation, consumers are cutting down on their consumption of fresh and premium fish while shifting to cheaper alternatives such as frozen or canned aquatic animals and lower value species.

High fuel prices constitute a significant concern for European fishers, who are increasingly featured in the media as practically being forced out of business. These elevated fuel costs have led to higher prices for aquatic foods, with some products selling by as much as EUR 3.00 per kg more than the previous levels in the past month. Not surprisingly, particularly strong price hikes are being seen for species from fuel intensive fisheries such as tuna, groundfish, and small pelagics.

The present European Fish Price Report records that 20 percent of prices have increased, 17 percent declined in May 2026 compared to April 2026, and 63 percent remained stable.

Prices

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The European Fish Price Report, based on information supplied by industry correspondents, aims to provide guidance on broad price trends. Price information is indicative and should be used only for forecasting medium- and long-term trends. FAO is not responsible for any errors or omissions.

Cephalopods

Octopus prices reached historic highs in major markets in 2025 amid persistent supply constraints in key producing regions. In Morocco, the winter octopus fishing season for 2026 ended on 31 March and is expected to reopen in July 2026. During the January–March 2026 period, coastal and artisanal landings of cephalopods totalled 25 841 tonnes, a decline of 3 percent compared with the same months in 2025.

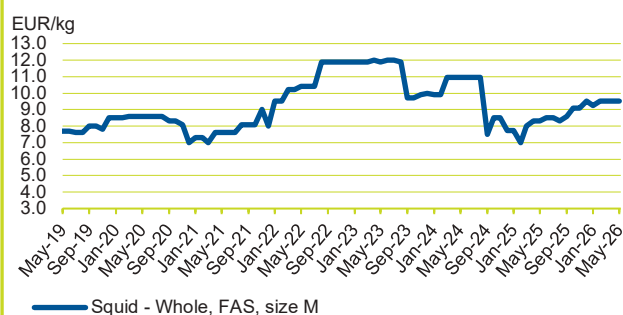
In Mauritania, the octopus fishing season ended on 1 May 2026. This was part of a comprehensive moratorium on cephalopod fishing that will apply to all fleet segments, following scientific recommendations calling for a biological rest period to support stock recovery.

In the European Union, average octopus prices during the January–March 2026 period remained broadly stable, recording a 1.1 percent increase compared with the same period in 2025.

In Argentina, squid (*Illex argentinus*) catches for January–March 2026 stood at 169 600 tonnes; this marked a sharp increase of 73.35 percent compared to the first quarter of 2025. Peruvian giant squid catches are also expected to go up in 2026. Squid prices in the first quarter of 2026 faced downward pressure, with prices of Peruvian giant squid falling more sharply compared to Argentine product owing to abundant supplies.

Crustaceans

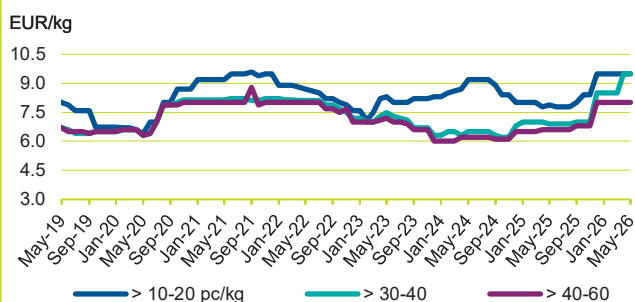
European shrimp imports declined by 7 percent year on year in the first quarter of 2026, reaching 86 931 tonnes, with import value down 15 percent to EUR 540 million compared to the same period of 2025. Demand was recorded as being weaker than the exceptionally strong 2025 levels. Higher inventories than in the first quarter of 2025 were reported in Southern Europe, the main shrimp consuming area. This, together with abundant global supply, led to pressure on prices during the first quarter of 2026.

The overall bleak economic outlook in the European Union, triggered by tensions in the Near East, is likely to negatively impact shrimp trading in the months to come.

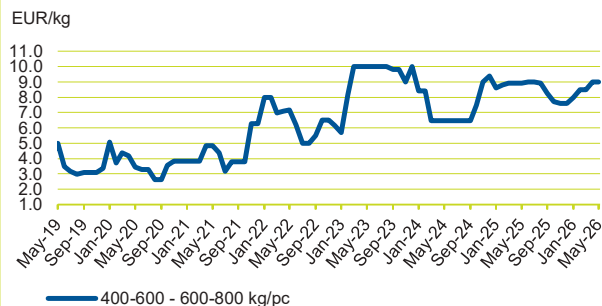
Shrimp is an interesting indicator of demand, with consumption being high in years when consumers perceive the economy as being good or excellent. Ecuador will export far more shrimp to Asia than to Europe in 2026. Asia is expected to take between 50 and 55 percent of exports, while Europe will take 20–23 percent. Europe is growing but still far smaller than China, which remains the anchor market for Ecuadorian shrimp. Europe is important but structurally smaller and more value driven.

Trout

Norway exported 5 863 tonnes of trout worth NOK 551 million (EUR 47.4 million) in April 2026, with a moderate decline in value and a sharper reduction in volume compared with the same month last year, according to the Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC).

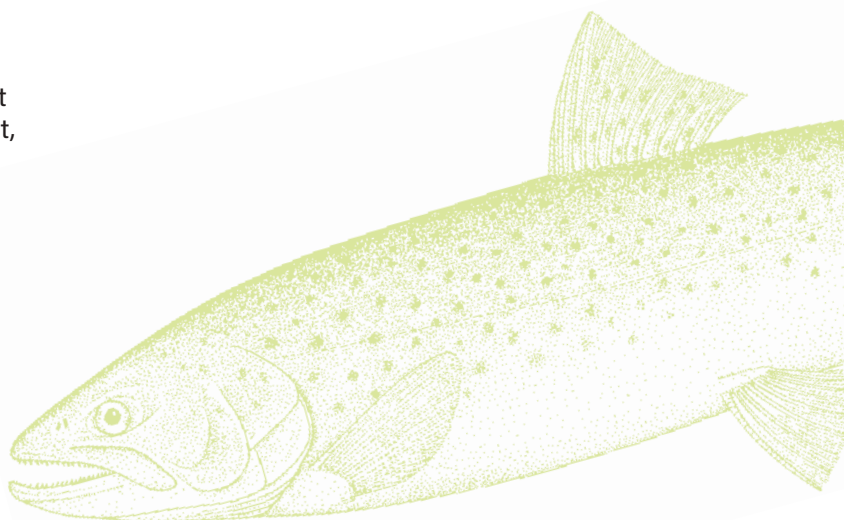
The United States, Poland and Ukraine were the largest markets during the month. Among these, Poland recorded the strongest growth, with export value increasing by NOK 27 million (EUR 2.3 million), up 57 percent, while volume rose by 53 percent to 898 tonnes. This reinforces Poland's role as a key destination for Norwegian trout, particularly in relation to processing and redistribution within Europe.

Despite lower overall volume, higher prices helped offset part of the decline. The average export price for fresh whole trout reached NOK 89.39 (EUR 7.69) per kg in April, 14 percent higher than in the same month last year.

Market conditions in April were influenced by broader trade disruptions. According to the institution, ongoing tensions in the Near East continued to affect logistics, increasing transport costs and reducing shipping capacity. As a result,

exports of trout declined to several markets in the region, as well as to selected Asian destinations. At the same time, shipments to the United States remained under pressure due to tariff-related uncertainty and a weaker US dollar, contributing to lower overall exports to that market.

Price data from the NSC, disseminated through the Undercurrent News Price Portal, indicate that prices for HOG fresh Norwegian trout, FOB at the border, reached NOK 80.02 (EUR 7.31) per kg in Week 18, marking a 6.54 percent increase from the previous week. This marks a break from the downward pattern observed since the start of the year, following several weeks of sustained declines.





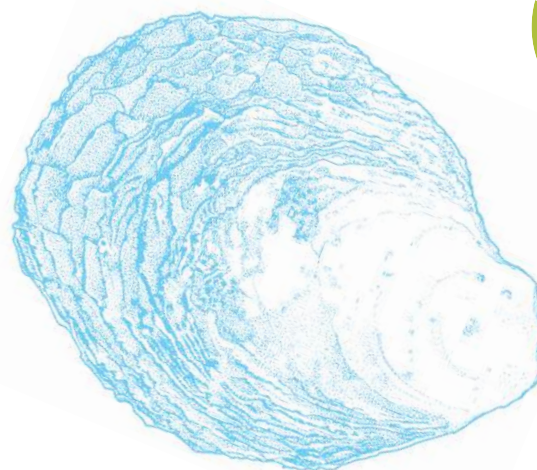
Bivalves

Bivalve prices went up in the course of the month of May, due to low availability in the market and increasing demand with the start of the summer period. Scallop prices are up by 10–20 percent, while mussel prices have risen by 15 percent.

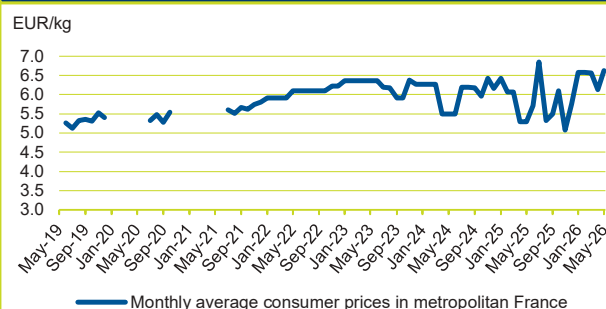
In Italy, the scarcity of Manila clams (*Ruditapes philippinarum*) due to the invasion of blue crab continues, with some production areas indicating that no clams will reach the market this year. However, clam prices went down slightly, from EUR 17.90 per kg in April 2026 to EUR 17.27 per kg in May 2026. On the contrary, wild venus clam (*Chamelea gallina*), which is the main replacement for Manila clam in the retail market, experienced a 20 percent price increase in the same period, to reach EUR 4.10 per kg.

Viet Nam is the dominant global supplier of pangasius products to the European market. The country has been experiencing a period of tight supply of raw fish, driven by lower fingerling survival rates, farmers holding fish back to wait for better prices, and high weather related production costs. Consequently, export prices have risen from September 2025 onward, with a clear upward trend expected for the time being as processors exhaust inventories.

Vietnamese pangasius exports to the European Union reached USD 61 million in January–April 2025, a 9 percent increase compared to the same period in 2024. However, the recovery was uneven; the Kingdom of the Netherlands reported a 15 percent increase in imports, but this country is a mere hub for re-export of the



MUSSEL BOUCHOT - in France

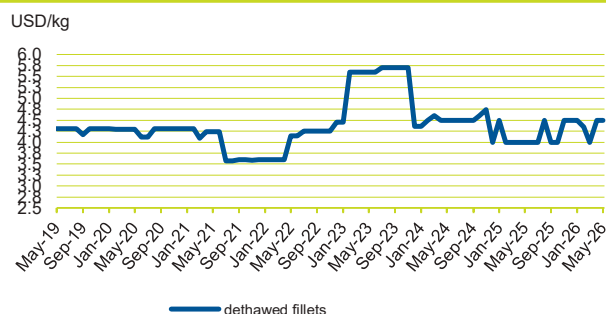


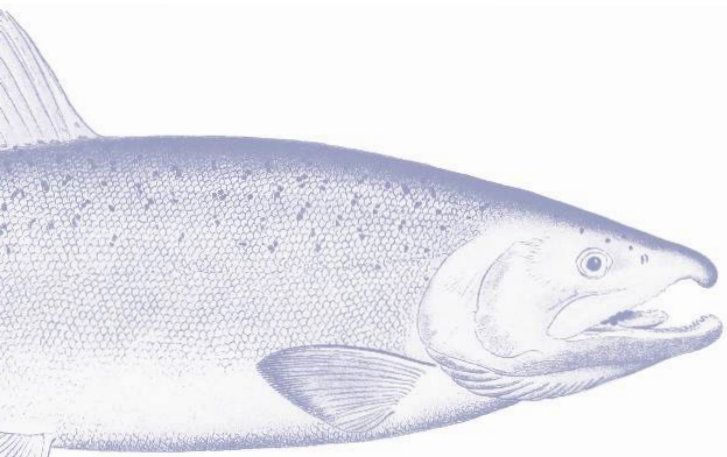

product. Germany, which has emerged as a main consumer of pangasius in the European Union in recent years, noted a 12 percent decline due to inflation, preference for salmon and cod, and strict certification requirements. Spain, another major consumer, also reported slower growth (-5 percent).

Norwegian salmon exports weakened in value terms in April 2026, despite a slight increase in volume, reflecting the combined effects of currency movements, higher logistics costs and shifting trade patterns across key markets.

Norway exported 104 894 tonnes of salmon worth NOK 9.3 billion (EUR 801 million) during the month, representing a 4 percent decline in value compared with April last year, while total volume increased by 1 percent. The average export price for fresh whole salmon stood at NOK 82.02 per kg (EUR 7.06), down 1 percent year-on-year.

The distribution of exports shifted during April 2026. Europe strengthened its position, accounting for 66 percent of the export value of Norwegian salmon, up 3 percent, while the share of the United States declined to 7 percent, down 4 percent. China increased its share to 10 percent, while the rest of Asia saw a slight contraction. Poland, China and Spain were the largest individual markets in that month.

China stood out as the main growth driver, with export value rising by 30 percent to NOK 925 million (EUR 79.7 million), supported by a



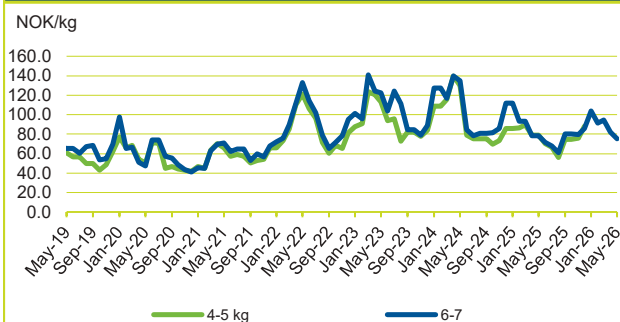

28 percent increase in volume to 10 430 tonnes. In contrast, exports to the United States fell sharply, declining by 39 percent in value to NOK 636 million (EUR 54.8 million), reflecting the continued impact of tariffs, a weaker dollar and intensified competition.

Regional developments were further influenced by disruptions in the Near East, where exports declined significantly amid higher freight costs, reduced shipping capacity and broader logistical constraints. At the same time, according to the Norwegian Seafood Council, currency effects, particularly the strengthening of the Norwegian krone against the US dollar, were a key factor behind the overall decline in export value in April. NSC data disseminated by the Undercurrent News Price Portal show that prices for fresh Atlantic salmon, FOB at the border, rose to NOK 83.74 (EUR 7.65) per kg in Week 18, marking a 9.64 percent increase from the previous week. This rebound follows a sustained downward trend observed over several weeks, during which prices declined steadily from earlier peaks.



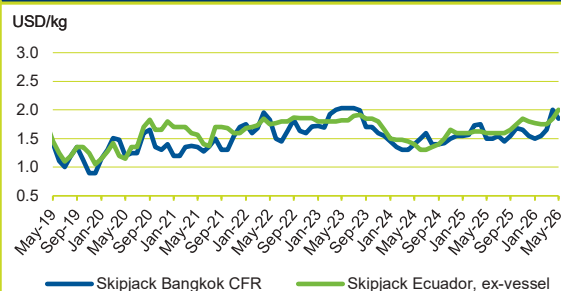
Salmon - origin: Norway



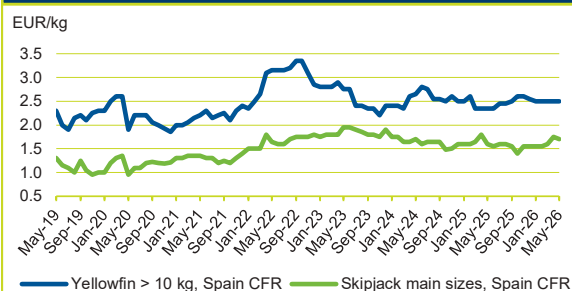
Tuna

The tuna market experienced some interesting price developments in May 2026. In Bangkok, the price dropped from USD 2 000 per tonne to USD 1 850 per tonne in just one month. In contrast, the skipjack price in Manta, which had been below the Bangkok price in April, saw a sudden rise to USD 2 000 per tonne due to a substantial decline in tuna catches in the Eastern Pacific. In the first quarter of 2026, some 233 600 tonnes were landed, 7 percent less than in the same period of 2025. This was mainly due to lower skipjack and bigeye landings, while yellowfin production was up.

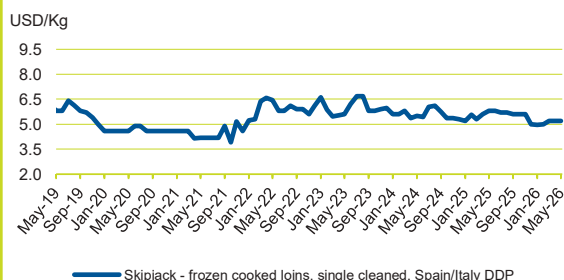
TUNA - Pacific Ocean



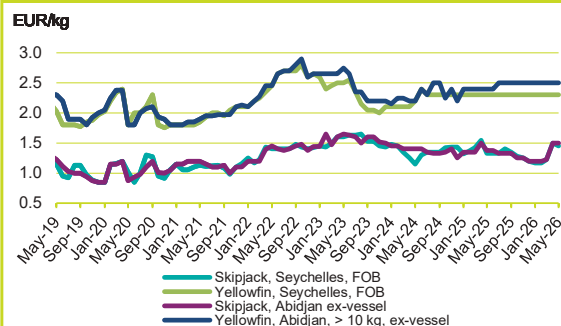
TUNA - Spanish canneries

TUNA - Indian/Atlantic Oceans





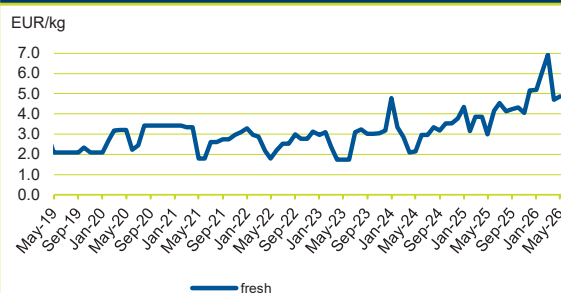
Small pelagics

Norwegian Atlantic mackerel prices have risen to levels not seen in the recent past, driven by significant harvest quota cuts in both 2025 and 2026. Consumers and processors are increasingly looking at cheaper species such as Pacific chub and Chilean jack mackerel as alternatives. Atlantic mackerel trade, nevertheless, is expected to see another record-high year in terms of value in 2026.

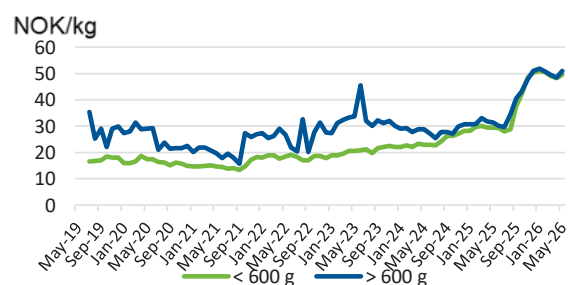
Herring consumption in Europe is seeing a strong upward trend in favour of high-value, smoked, canned and marinated products.

In 2025, Morocco remained the biggest global producer and exporter of canned sardine, with an annual volume of about 15 000 tonnes, supplying markets ranging from Europe to the Near East and Asia. The top importing countries for canned sardine last year included the United States of America, South Africa, the Dominican Republic, France and Malaysia.

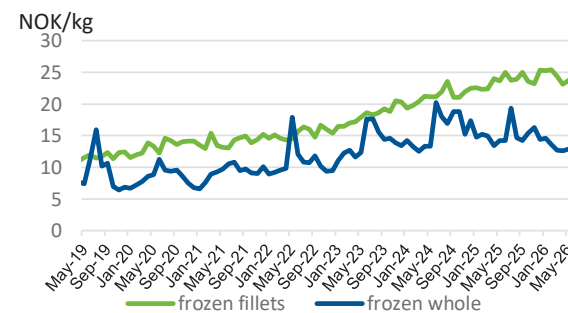
Mackerel - in Italy, origin: France

Herring - origin: Norway



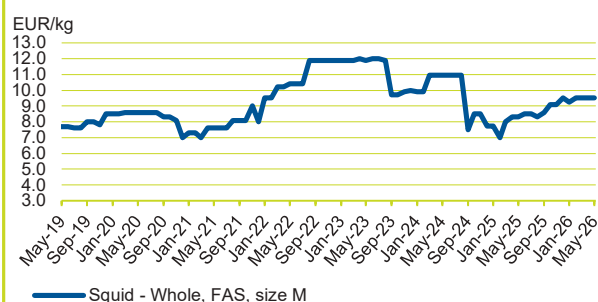


Seabass and seabream

There are marked differences in the Italian market with regard to seabass prices. Large cultured seabream saw a price increase of EUR 1.00 per kg to reach almost EUR 11.00 per kg, due to good demand from the restaurant trade.

The prices of cultured seabass from Greece went up by 2 percent in the course of the month, in line with higher shipment costs (airfreight). However, product from Greece and Türkiye is selling at about EUR 2.00 per kg less than the same product from Sardinia, indicating increased consumer preference for locally produced fish. It is also worth noting that within the country, Sardinian farmed seabass is being sold at EUR 3.50 per kg more than product from the Tuscany region (Orbetello) due to its premium positioning.

SQUID - in Italy, origin: South Africa



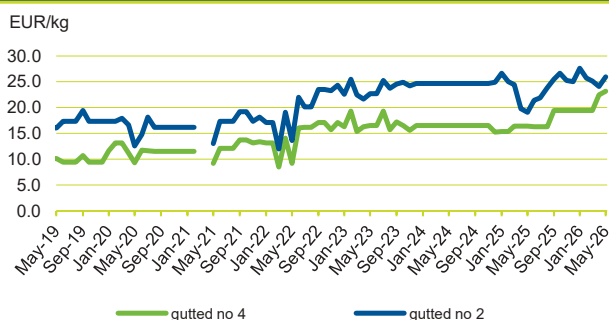

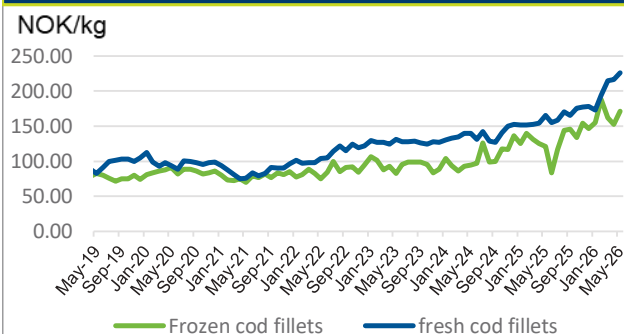
In the wake of a Norwegian fishing season that was not very profitable, the price of *Gadus morhua* has increased significantly, leading to lower consumption of the product. In addition, cured cod is traditionally not popular outside of the colder months of the year.

Hake prices have increased by about EUR 1.00 per kg in the French wholesale market in response to the sharp increase of fuel prices in the country.
