Latest trends

Summer is usually very hot in Europe, not really presenting the best weather conditions for fish consumption. In most countries, demand is slow and overall prices are stable. The main exception is cod, which is being sold at prices that have reached record-high levels. The present European Fish Price Report records that 19 percent of prices have increased, 18 percent declined in July 2026 compared to June 2026, and 63 percent have remained stable.

The main tourist spots report good demand for fresh fish, with frozen pangasius fillets having also found their way to the HORECA sector. However, as most restaurants had stocked up earlier with supplies, the prevailing demand is very slow, even in the main tourist locations in Southern Europe. In the northern part of the continent, the market is calmer, as many people have travelled elsewhere for their summer vacation. At the Rungis wholesale market in Paris, almost all prices are stable when compared with the previous month.

Norwegian exports of fisheries and aquaculture products have been impressive, considering the present shifting trade policy landscape. In the first half of the year, Norway exported 1.3 million tonnes of aquatic products worth NOK 84.5 billion (USD 8.7 billion), down by 2 percent and 1 percent respectively, compared with the same period last year. Aquaculture accounts for 73 percent of these exports by value and 54 percent by volume.

Trade in fisheries and aquaculture products in January–June 2026 was influenced by both domestic and international factors. In Norway, reduced quotas for several wild-caught species have resulted in record-low export volumes and record-high export prices, whilst geopolitical unrest in global markets has made trade challenging. The largest markets for Norwegian aquatic products in the first half of the year were Poland, China and the United States of America, with increases noted for the first two countries.

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The European Fish Price Report, based on information supplied by industry correspondents, aims to provide guidance on broad price trends. Price information is indicative and should be used only for forecasting medium- and long-term trends. FAO is not responsible for any errors or omissions.



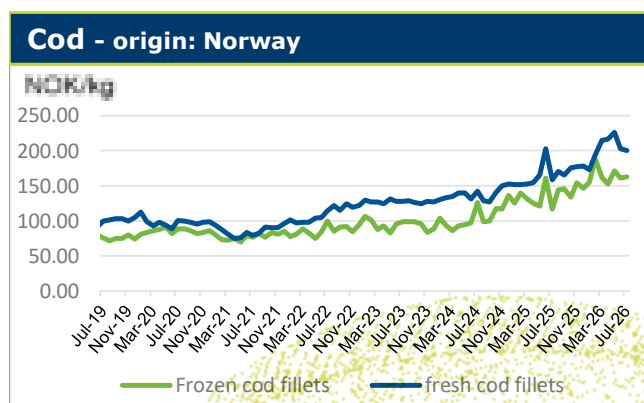
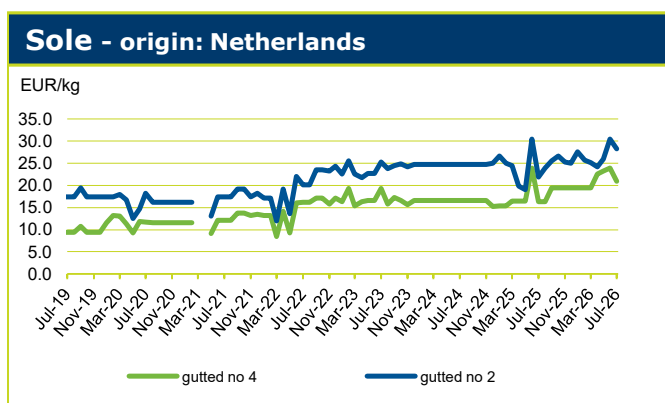
Groundfish

The lowest cod quotas for Norway since 1991 mean that landings of frozen cod in the first half of the year were the lowest since the turn of the millennium. Consequently, competition for raw materials in the Norwegian processing industry is fiercer than ever. An ever-increasing proportion of Norwegian landings of fresh cod is being used for the production of salted fish, stockfish and clipfish. This is at the expense of the export volume of fresh wild cod.

The very low harvest volumes, combined with sanctions against Russian cod in several key markets, have contributed to record-high export prices for frozen whole cod. For the first time in history, the average price for frozen whole cod has exceeded NOK 100 per kg (USD 10.40) in a half-year period, standing at NOK 104 per kg. This is NOK 10 higher than the previous record half-year, which was in the second half of 2025.

The cured cod market, which generally experiences stable prices, has also experienced sudden significant price increases this month due to the difficult cod fishing situation. Prices of stockfish have increased from EUR 26.00 per kg to EUR 45.00 per kg for the 2026–2027 season. Other cured products also saw higher prices; for instance, wet salted cod fillets reached EUR 20.00 per kg, up from EUR 13.00 per kg and it needs to be seen whether consumers will be willing to accept these 50 percent price hikes. At the moment, demand is low, as cured cod is considered a winter food item.

In recent years, there has been a decline in the number of Portuguese people buying clipfish, how often they buy it, and how much they buy each time. In the first half of 2026, there was a 15 percent decline in grocery sales of traditional clipfish flakes.



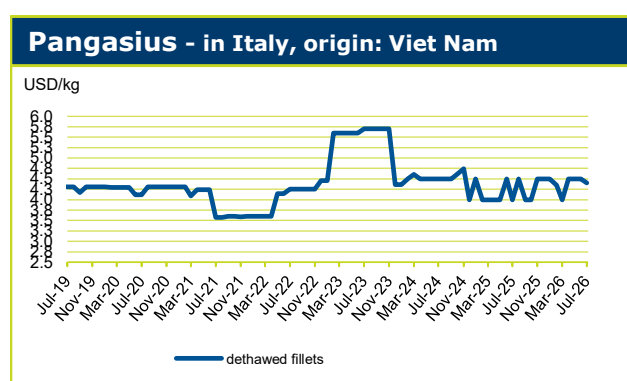
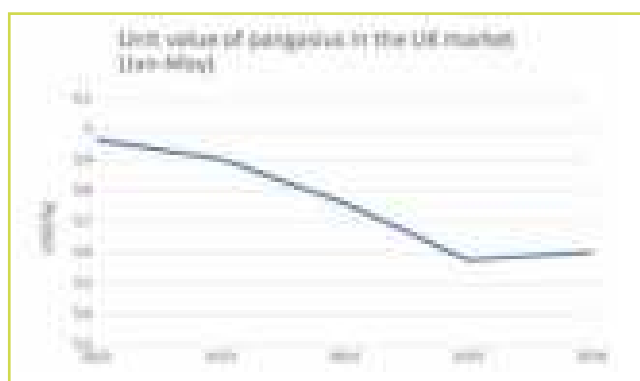


Freshwater fish

The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland relies almost entirely on imported pangasius, primarily from Viet Nam. This creates a price environment driven by Vietnamese farm-gate trends, whitefish shortages in the European Union and the United Kingdom, and logistics costs.

Pangasius is a well-liked substitute for cod or other wild groundfish in the preparation of fish and chips in the United Kingdom, where the market was valued at USD 158.81 million in 2025. In the first five months of 2026, the country imported 7 700 tonnes of pangasius, some 10 percent more than in the same period last year.

The present price of pangasius is about half that of frozen cod, which explains the interest in this species. In addition, pangasius has a neutral taste, which makes it very well-suited for frying. Meanwhile, prices in the United Kingdom have recovered in the course of 2026, from the relatively low level reached in January to May 2025.





Trout

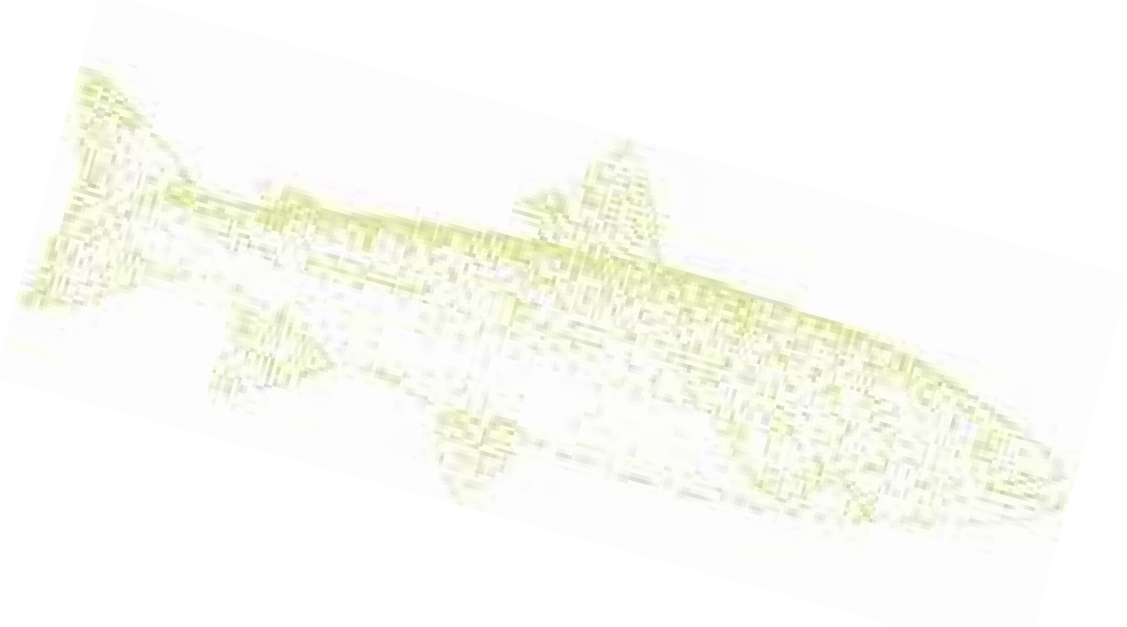
Norwegian trout exports contracted during the first half of 2026, with lower volumes and export earnings compared with the same period last year. Data from the Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC) show that Norway exported 35 394 tonnes of trout worth NOK 3.2 billion (EUR 275 million) between January and June, representing year-on-year declines of 10 percent in volume and 8 percent in value.

According to NSC analysts, the weaker performance in the trout sector this year reflects adjustments in Norwegian aquaculture, as producers have increasingly favoured salmon farming over trout. This shift in production strategy has contributed to the decline in export volumes recorded during the first six months of the year.

The United States, Poland and Ukraine were the main destinations for Norwegian trout from January to June 2026. Poland posted the strongest growth, reinforcing its role as a major processing and distribution centre for Norwegian fisheries and aquaculture products within Europe.

Meanwhile, exports to the United States continued to face pressure from the ongoing 15 percent tariff levied on Norwegian aquatic products, which has reversed the growth trend observed in recent years and reduced export revenues from that market.

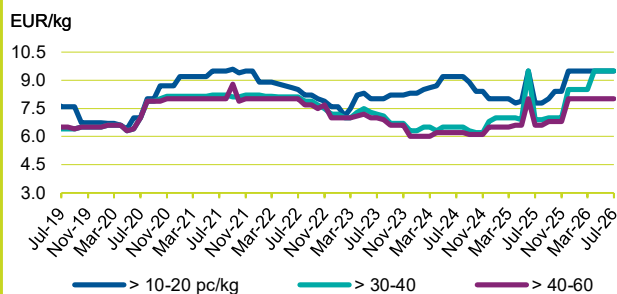
Looking at June alone, Norway exported 7 900 tonnes of trout worth NOK 640 million (EUR 55.0 million), up 18 percent in both volume and value compared with the same month in 2025. Market quotations disseminated through the Undercurrent News Price Portal indicate that the price of HOG fresh Norwegian trout, FOB at the border, reached NOK 76.35 (EUR 6.56) per kg in Week 28, up 2.86 percent from the previous week. Price movements during early July remained relatively moderate, with values fluctuating within a narrow range.



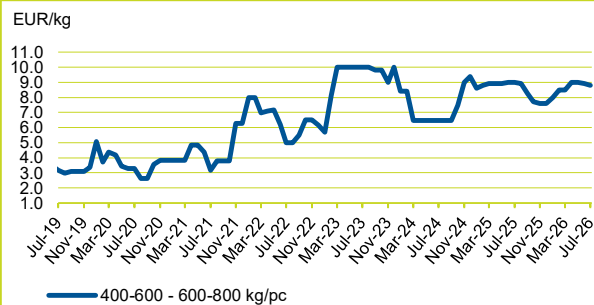
Crustaceans

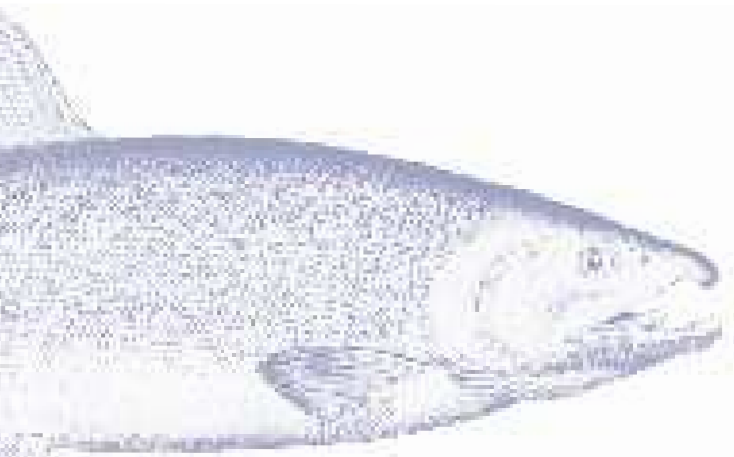
The most recent prices for FOB head-on shell-on Ecuadorian vannamei (whiteleg shrimp) ranged roughly from USD 5.35–5.55/kg for 20/30 sizes, with smaller sizes (40/50 and below) remaining tight and priced higher, and larger sizes (10/20) being in good supply and slightly cheaper. Supplies of the 40/50 counts are unusually tight, with the highest demand reported in Europe; prices for these sizes are higher than 20/30 shrimp due to their scarcity.

CRAB - in France, origin: Europe

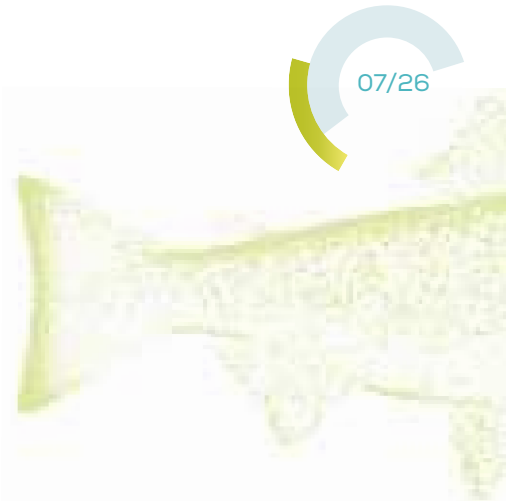




Salmon continued to dominate Norwegian seafood exports in the first half of 2026, accounting for nearly seven out of every ten export krone generated by the sector. According to the Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC), Norway exported 655 598 tonnes of salmon worth NOK 58 billion (EUR 4.99 billion) between January and June, representing an 8 percent rise in volume and a 1 percent increase in value compared with the same period last year. Exports in June alone amounted to 129 800 tonnes of salmon worth NOK 10.1 billion (EUR 869 million), up 19 percent in volume and 11 percent in value compared with June 2025.

The strong growth in production was accompanied by lower average prices. NSC analysts note that Norwegian salmon output reached its highest level on record during the first half of 2026, while the appreciation of the Norwegian krone against both the US dollar and the euro, together with trade barriers implemented by the United States market, have contributed to the lowest first-half export prices for fresh whole salmon since 2021. Poland, China and France were the main destinations for Norwegian salmon during that period.

China also strengthened its position as one of Norway's key salmon markets. During the first half of the year, exports to that market increased by 51 percent in volume and 42 percent in value, building on the strong expansion already recorded in 2025. At the same time, Norwegian salmon's share in Chinese imports rose. The NSC attributes this performance to sustained growth in Chinese demand, supported by wider distribution networks, expanding online sales channels and increasing consumption in smaller cities.

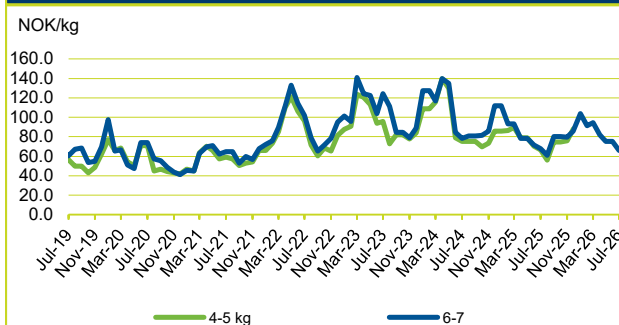


Salmon

In contrast, trade with the United States remained under pressure. Although the country continued to be Norway's largest destination for salmon fillets, exports of both fresh and frozen fillets declined sharply during the first half of the year. The value share of processed salmon products fell from 30 percent to 25 percent, reflecting the impact of tariffs and uncertainty surrounding future market access. Exports of fresh fillets to the United States fell by 38 percent, while frozen fillet shipments declined by 32 percent compared with the same period last year.

NSC data disseminated by the Undercurrent News Price Portal show that prices for fresh Atlantic salmon, FOB at the border, stood at NOK 70.56 (EUR 6.07) per kg in Week 28, down 1.51 percent from the previous week. Price developments during June and early July remained volatile, although the overall trend was downward. After briefly recovering in Week 27, prices resumed their decline and remained well below the levels observed at the beginning of the year.

Salmon - origin: Norway



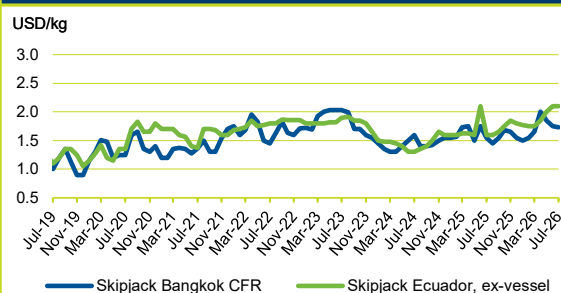
Tuna

The impact of the El Niño will be unique to each country. Tuna resources are likely to migrate towards the Central Pacific where warming waters will meet currents coming from the Eastern Pacific, rich with plankton and small fish. Meanwhile, some Pacific Island countries are likely to experience higher tuna catches, as the ocean temperatures around them could be warmer than normal. The biological re-distribution of tuna stocks will attract international fishing fleets to these countries, increasing the issuance of fishing licences and boosting national revenue.

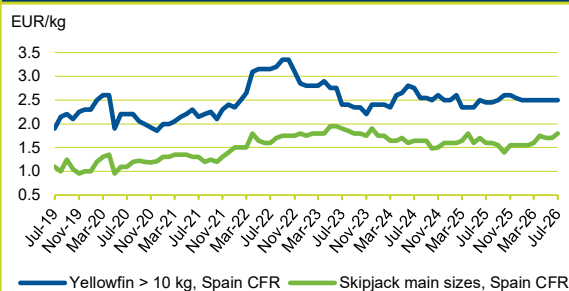
On the other hand, fishing nations which traditionally operate in the Eastern Pacific, particularly Ecuador, are likely to experience lower tuna catches, causing their fleets to move towards the Central Pacific. Countries fishing in the Indian Ocean are likely to be negatively impacted.

In the meantime, tuna prices are stable at the slightly lower levels reached in June 2026, when the reduction in fuel prices had a positive impact on costs for the world tuna fishing industry.

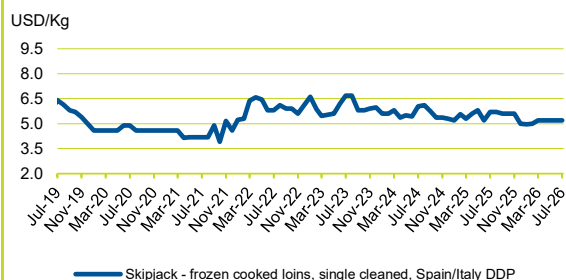
TUNA - Pacific Ocean



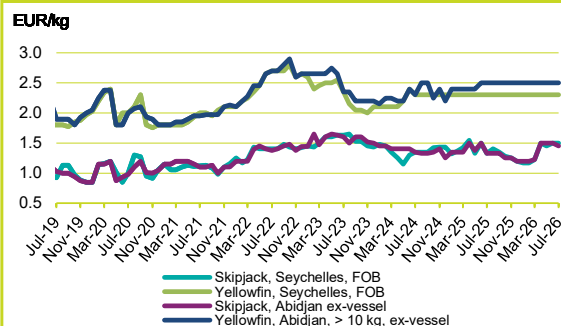
TUNA - Spanish canneries

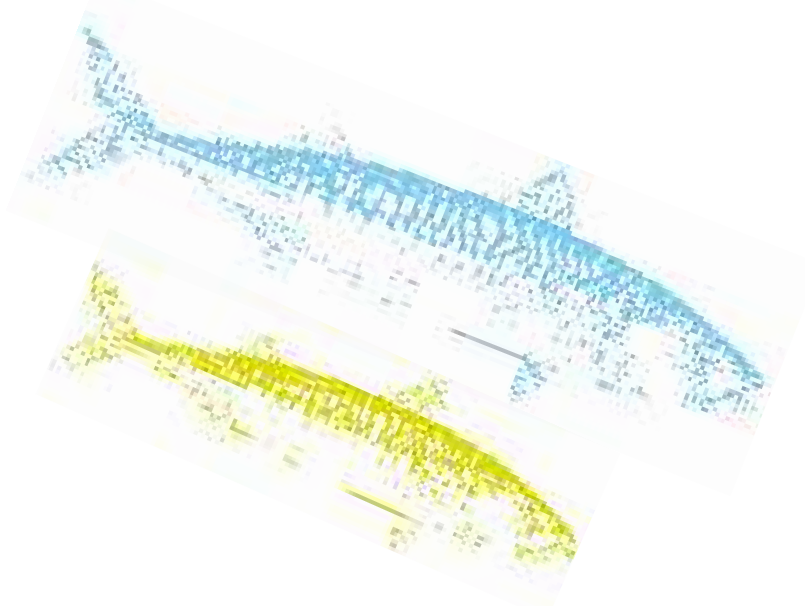


TUNA - Loins

Small pelagics

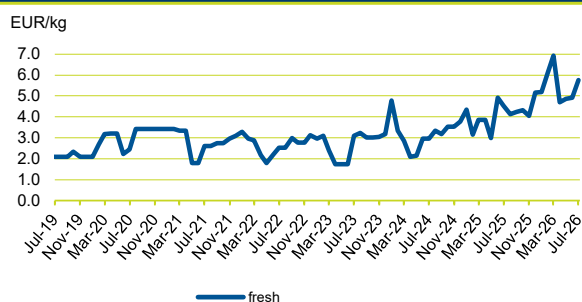
Mackerel supply is very short this year due to lower total allowable catches (TACs) in Northern Europe. As a result, the price of mackerel fillets in the Italian market went up by EUR 1.00 per kg in just one month.

Mackerel exports from Norway in the first half of the year were characterized by historic high prices due to a sharp 67 percent reduction in quotas and low landings from foreign vessels. In the first half of the year, Norway exported 38 344 tonnes of mackerel worth NOK 2 billion (USD 0.21 billion), registering year-on-year drops of 21 percent in value and 51 percent in volume. The Republic of Korea, the United States and Viet Nam were the largest markets for mackerel during that period.

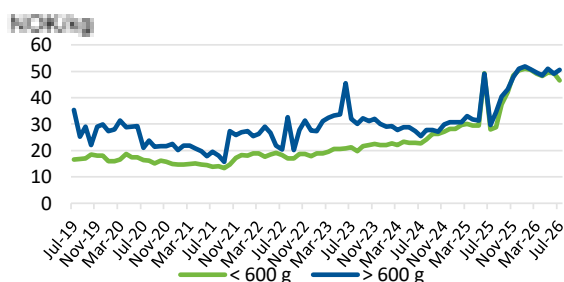
In contrast to mackerel, Norway experienced excellent herring catches this year, coming from a 33 percent increase in the spring-spawning herring quota and a strong winter fishing season, during which 64 percent more was landed than the previous year.

In the first half of this year, Norway exported 139 517 tonnes of herring worth NOK 2.6 billion (USD 0.27 billion), up by 29 percent in value and 40 percent in volume compared to the same period in 2025. Poland, Egypt and Lithuania were the largest markets for Norwegian herring, where Poland processes herring for the German market.

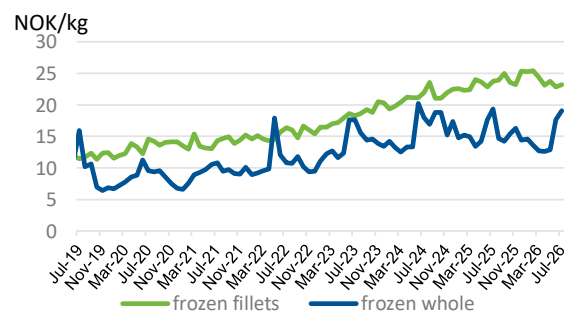
Mackerel - in Italy, origin: France

Herring - origin: Norway



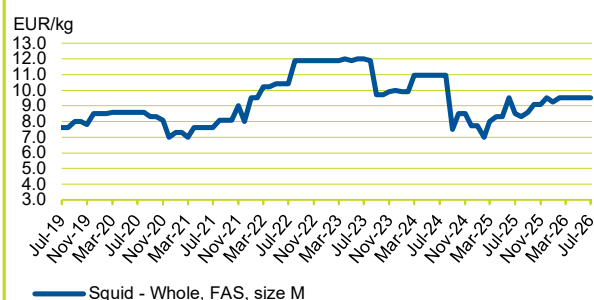
Cephalopods

Global octopus supply is currently tight and prices remain historically high. Across all major origins (Morocco, Mauritania, China and Spain), 2026 is continuing last year's trend of constrained landings and elevated wholesale prices. The winter season for octopus catches in Morocco closed on 31 March; cephalopod landings, including octopus, amounted to 25 841 tonnes in the first quarter of 2026, a 3 percent decrease from the same period of 2025. Also worth noting is that the total output in 2025 was 50 000 tonnes, 18 percent less than in 2024. This low production trend has meant tight supplies for European Union buyers, mainly Spain and Italy. Morocco's new season later this month may ease supply slightly, but landings are likely to remain below historical averages.

The Mauritanian octopus season ended on 1 May 2026 due to a moratorium on harvesting to allow for stock recovery. Octopus landings in 2025 had

reached 13 760 tonnes, 9 percent less than in 2024. With Mauritania being one of the most important origins for large-sized octopus, the moratorium significantly reduces global availability, especially of the large specimens traditionally used for Galician-style octopus cuisine in Spain.

SQUID - in Italy, origin: South Africa



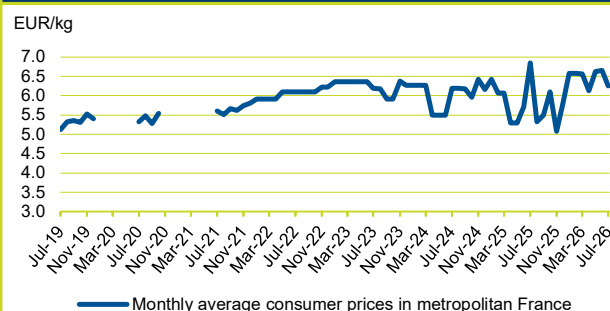
Bivalves

The Italian clam market appears to have normalized. After wholesale prices exceeding EUR 20.00 per kg were reported for Manila clam (*Ruditapes philippinarum*) in April 2026, prices have settled to the present level of EUR 10.30 per kg, which is normal for this time of the year. The price drop for wild venus clam (*Chamelea gallina*) is less steep, registering a decline of EUR 1.00 per kg in just one month, to EUR 5.50 per kg.

The combined efforts by fishers, culturists and the authorities to decrease the blue crab population in the upper Adriatic Sea (the main producing area of Manila clam), seem to be showing results. In particular, blue crab can now be found in the

HORECA market while television programmes are promoting recipes for blue crab, underlining its low price and high nutritional value.

MUSSEL BOUCHOT - in France



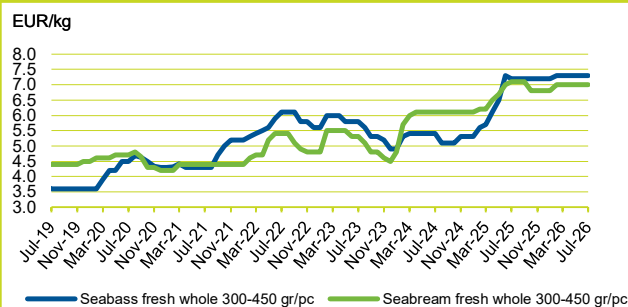
Seabass and seabream

Wild seabass is in very good demand due to interest from white cloth restaurants all over Europe. In the Rungis wholesale market in France, prices of line-caught seabass increased by EUR 1.00 per kg, to reach EUR 35.00 per kg for a 2–3 kg fish. Wild seabream also experienced price hikes of EUR 1–2 per kg in just one month in this market while cultured seabass and seabream stayed stable.

In Spain, wholesale prices of fresh whole gilthead seabream remained firm during 2025 and into the first half of 2026, particularly for medium and large sizes. Smaller seabream (300–400 g) traded closer to EUR 7.00–7.45 per kg earlier in the year but softened from May onwards, dropping to about EUR 6.90 per kg in July 2026. This suggests some easing in short-term demand or improved availability of smaller fish. Medium-sized seabream (400–600 g) showed the clearest upward momentum, reaching EUR 8.50 per kg in early July, supported by steady demand from retail and foodservice channels. Larger seabream (600 g) also strengthened, moving above EUR 10.00 per kg before edging down slightly to EUR 10.30 per kg in July.

The Spanish seabass market also saw firm prices in early 2026. Large-sized seabass held at around the EUR 12.00 per kg level, and rose to EUR 13.00 per kg in July, pointing to continued tightness in supply. Medium-sized seabass increased steadily from late 2025 into 2026, reaching EUR 9.20 per kg. The prices for small-sized seabass were comparatively stable, fluctuating at around EUR 5.50–6.00 per kg; in July, the price was about EUR 5.90 per kg, suggesting a more balanced supply-demand situation for smaller sizes.
